FOR A FUTURE TO COME

This project called “**FOR A FUTURE TO COME – International Youth Work on Conflict Management**” is planned to run for 27 months and it is dedicated to the Youth in Action Programme to promote conflict management. Our main aim is to train youth workers from European Union countries and Eastern European and Caucasian (EECA) countries in conflict management. We will establish a Trans-European youth network. This network will consist of non-governmental organisations that deal with inter-personal and inter-cultural conflict at local, national and international levels.

The project will involve partners from Georgia, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Poland, Germany and the United Kingdom. The main events include a Training of Trainers, two training courses on conflict resolution, two Contact Making Seminars about cooperation between European Union and EECA countries, and three youth exchanges.

The main outcomes will be the trained youth workers, the creation of a youth platform on effective conflict management, the publication of two training manuals and a video clip presenting our project and specific methodologies of conflict resolution.

AIMS

- > **To RAISE** the visibility of the Youth in Action Programme in Eastern Europe
- > **To TRAIN** youth workers of EECA and EU countries in conflict management and conflict resolution
- > **To ESTABLISH** a Trans-European youth network for intercultural youth projects dedicated to conflict resolution
- > **To BUILD** new partnerships between EU countries and partner countries from EECA region to create new project ideas within the Youth in Action Programme
- > **To PROVIDE** knowledge about the possibilities of co-operation with Eastern Europe within the International Cooperation of Youth in Action Programme
- > **To PROMOTE** the implementation of youth projects in Eastern Europe and Caucasus region
